Financial Document Checklist & Form

One of your first assignments in a divorce proceeding will be to gather the paperwork necessary to document you and your spouse's income, assets, and debts. In many instances, these documents are required by Washington State law in a divorce. Some of the documents you may have access to and others your spouse may have access to.

The following list is not exhaustive but if you can provide them to your attorney, it will greatly help them prepare your case. If you typically do not keep documents (bank statements for example), you can often obtain several months from your financial institutions online system or you can order copies directly from the financial institution.
